MISSION STATEMENT AND HISTORY:

The mission of the Interdenominational Ministers Fellowship Treasure Feamster Scholarship is to honor the memory of Treasure Feamster of Salisbury, North Carolina. At the age of 13 as an 8th grader her life was taken too soon during a random act of violence. The family, churches, individual supporters and the communities had a desire to turn this act of violence into an opportunity to combat crimes locally. The IMF set in place a scholarship committee governed by the IMF Board of Directors to handle the scholarship application and award process. A scholarship to help high school seniors who meet the established qualifications, and whose desire is to further their education; by continuing their education with a specific focus in the area of Criminal Justice/Law was initiated. The number of scholarships awarded annually is based on available funds and need.

As mentioned, the Initial educational focus for the scholarship included areas of Criminal Justice/Law, <u>but</u> <u>currently applications from all majors are accepted</u>. Priority will be given to students from low income families. **Scholarship winners must maintain a 2.0 GPA for the fall semester.**

Applicant Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible for the IMF Treasure Feamster Scholarship applicants must:

- 1. Be a current member of an IMF affiliated church. (See attached list, which is subject to change)
- 2. Be enrolled as a senior in high school for current academic year.
- 3. Plan to attend an accredited college or university through graduation.
- 4. Plan to continue their education with any field of study leading to an Associates or Bachelors Degree that will be impactful in giving back to the community.

Required Eligibility Documents:

- Complete the accompanying scholarship application and essay.
 (Note: We strongly encourage parents, family members, clergy, counselors, and/or teachers to offer the applicant guidance in grammar, structure, and overall content.)
- 2. Provide a sealed official transcript.
- 3. Submit <u>at least three sealed letters of recommendation</u> written by a teacher, coach, counselor, youth advisor or clergy of your choice.
