- paid to the institution in which the student is enrolled to be applied to tuition, room and board during the first year.
- repaid in the event a student drops out of the institution during the year for which the scholarship was given. The terms for repayment will be agreed upon with the Scholarships Committee.
- for one year only, at the present time!

- be a graduating senior at South Rowan High School, Carson High School and/or a member and/or the child or grandchild of a member of Mount Zion United Church of Christ.
- be of good moral character,
- be a member of a Christian church,
- have a good academic record,
- show financial need,
- be entering an institution of higher learning such as: Technical School, Community College, College, or University,
- submit a transcript of high school grades,
- fill out the necessary application,
- give three personal references, (submitted with application)
- be interviewed by the Scholarships Committee.
